Hello Kids' Plates Grantees,

It was so nice meet and talk with all of you at the Kids' Plates grantee meeting last month. I hope you found the meeting and the afternoon training interesting and useful.

Just a couple of reminders...

...you may invoice for program expenditures of up to 75% of your grant award. The remaining 25% of your grant may be invoiced as your "final invoice" and sent along with your final required documents.

...all program and fiscal templates have been provided to you in the CD Rom that was handed out at the September Kids' Plates meeting. If you need any of these templates again, please email me with your request and I will send you what you need.

...if you think you may have a Kids' Plates budget surplus, let's talk. We can probably find a way for you to use those funds.

Remember, you can move up to 10% of your total KP budget (within existing budget lines) without permission. You will need to submit a formal amendment and receive approval, before moving anything over a total of 10% of the budget, or if you need to create a new budget line, regardless of the amount.
