### Vehicle Backover Avoidance Technology Study

NHTSA has released its long-awaited 65-page report to Congress on vehicle backovers.

*Portion of the Executive Summary:* This report responds to congressional interest and requirements to examine the safety problem of motor vehicle backover crashes involving pedestrians and the evaluation of available technologies that might help to reduce them. Special interest was expressed regarding the involvement of small children in these types of crashes.
