Graduated Licensing Law Effective July 1, 1998 Vehicle Code 12814.6 (b)

First Six Months

V.C. 12814.6(b)(1)(B) - Cite provisional driver when transporting passenger under the age of 20 years, when no licensed driver at least 25 years of age is in vehicle.

V.C. 12814.6(b)(1)(A) - Cite provisional driver when driving between the hours of midnight and 5:00 a.m., when no licensed driver at least 25 years of age is in vehicle.

Second 6 Months

V.C. 12814.6(b)(2)(A) - Cite provisional driver when driving between the hours of midnight and 5:00 a.m., when no licensed driver at least 25 years of age is in vehicle.

Per section 12814.6 (c) - A law enforcement officer shall not stop a vehicle for the sole purpose of determining whether the driver is in violation of the restrictions imposed under subdivision

First 6 Months

Newly licensed drivers ages 16 & 17 must be accompanied by a licensed driver at least 25 years old or a driving instructor:

- When transporting passengers under age 20 years of age at any time.
- When driving between midnight and 5 a.m.

Second 6 Months

Newly licensed drivers ages 16 & 17 must be accompanied by a licensed driver at least 25 years old, or a driving instructor:

When driving between midnight and 5 a.m.



Exceptions: A newly licensed driver may transport an *immediate* family member or drive unsupervised during the restricted hours under the following circumstances:

- (A) **Medical necessity**: the teen must have a signed statement from a physician containing a diagnosis and the probable expiration date.
- (B) **School-authorized activities**: the teen must have a signed statement from school staff which includes the probable expiration date.
- (C) **Employment**: the teen must have a signed statement from the employer, verifying employment and the probable expiration date.
- (D) Inadequate family transportation: the teen must have a signed statement from a parent or legal guardian verifying the reason and probable expiration date.
- (E) The licensee is an emancipated minor.
